## Addendum to Appendix 1 - When to use the Design Codes

The table below identifies all the codes within this document. A prefix has been created for each code to allow simple application and referencing of the Design Codes for the Neighbourhood Plan. It also shows which codes are relevant to the Countryside and Settlement Focus Areas (CFA/ SFA). This allows for more nuanced application in response to the development pressures within each area.

It is intended that the Design Codes, in conjunction with the Neighbourhood Plan, will ensure that the development which materialists Southwell in over the Neighbourhood Plan period will be: contextually responsive; attractive; functional; and most importantly, will meet the design aspirations of the local community
